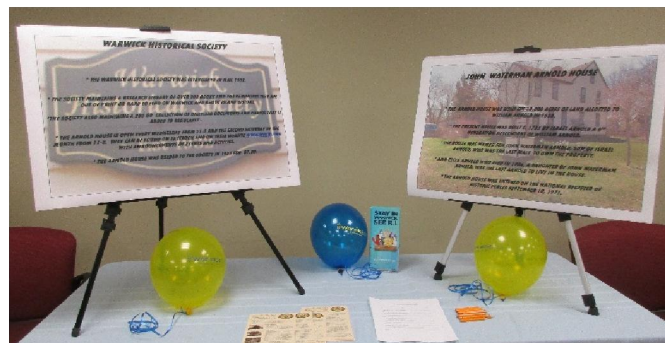




WARWICK HISTORICAL SOCIETY NEWSLETTER DECEMBER 2017

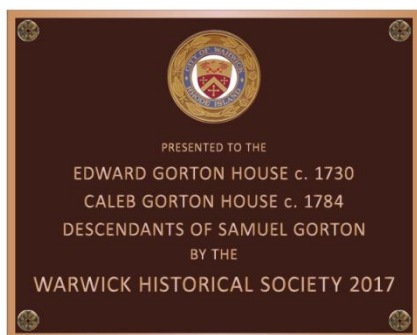
MAP RESTORATION PROJECT

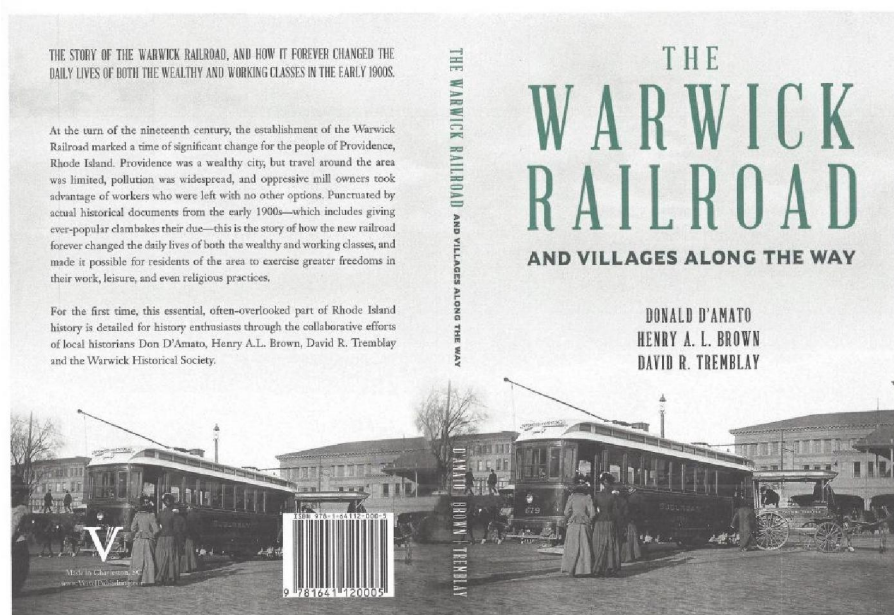
